6. Entry and insurance

If the drivers' intention to start is obstacled, he must inform the Organiser immediately in written form - email, fax or printed - latest by the beginning of the administrative checking. Otherwise the Off-Road Committee will penalize him. Entries are accepted after the closing date for entries, too, with a reservation according to the regulation.

Entry fee is to be paid during administrative checking.

This includes the entry fee, insurance and the usage fee of the paddock, too.

Entrance permission

The organiser provides service tickets for 5 persons of each competitor (driver + 4 persons) and a paddock ticket (car ticket), which can be received at the scene (the Paddock gate) on arrival.

Timing:

There is transponder timing during the race. Every driver is obliged to use a transponder. Those drivers who do not have an own transponder can hire one for the race for 4,000,-, HUF, 10€ at the administration checking.

Insurance:

Every driver must have drivers' insurance. During the entry an insurance premium must be taken out which guarantees the competitors' cover for Third Party Liability towards third parties. The insurance is valid from start of the event and brakes off at the end of the event or in case of falling out or exclusion.

7. Prizes

According to the CEZ and National regulation.

The podium ceremony for the Hungarian Championship and CEZ will at tha Pre-grid area.

8. Reservation of rights and the responsibility of the starters

The organiser reserves the right to change the current Regulation until the beginning of the race with the following conditions: in case of a change, the drivers are informed with a Bullettin including a date and an order number, which is approved by the department in advance, from the start of the race this right applies to the Stewards. By signing the registration form, the drivers subject themselves to the regulations of the Regulation of the Event and the Bulletins. Participating the race is the risk of the drivers. By signing the registration sheet, the drivers state, they have no claims for damages towards the organizer resp. they waive a claim for damages.

9. Environment protection regulations

Each driver has to have an at least 4x5 m plastic foil at the place provided for the team, where repair work is done on the car in order to avoid pollution caused by any leakage and a 150 litre plastic bin liner to collect rubbish/waste. They can be checked at any time during the competition. Possible deficiencies can be punished by the Stewards!

Charging electric cars in the paddock area is strictly prohibited!

10. Safety regulations

Each driver has to have a minimum 5 kg loaded fire extinguisher in working order at their own paddock area. They can be checked at any time during the competition. Possible deficiencies can be punished by the Stewards!

11. Checkings

Administrative checkings

Only drivers must report to administrative checking which will be held at the administrative office with valide car passport.

Scrutineering – technical checking

Any car taking part in the Event must be presented to the scrutineering (Scrutineering Area). Any car arriving after the closure of scrutineering may be refused permission to start. Noise: For all cars, a limit of 100 dB is imposed, measured with a noise pressure meter regulated at "A" and "SLOW", placed at an angle of 45° to and a distance of 50 cm from the exhaust outlet. During the checking the car's engine must be turning at 4500 revolutions per minute. The fitting of heat retaining devices or pre-heating is prohibited. This applies both wet-weather and dry-weather tyres.

12. Running of the event

Practice: Each driver must complete at least one timed lap during the practice. Should this not be the case, he may be allowed to start at the discretion of the Stewards.

Time practice:	4 laps
Heats:	5 laps
SemiFinals:	6 laps
Finals:	7 laps

13. Parc Ferme, Rresults – Protests

Parc Fermé

After the final races of the event, those cars that have been flagged down in the final race or those drivers excluded from the final with their cars have to drive directly to the official Parc Fermé and the cars stay there at least 30 minutes after the publication of the results. The Stewards decide about the end of prohibition. In this zone it is strictly forbidden to carry out any kind of repair work on the car, refilling is not permitted, either.

Results

Protests, appeals

The right to protest is reserved to the competitor. Protests shall be lodged in accordance with the relevant points of the FIA International Sporting Code and the MNASZ General Sporting Rules and Regulations. If the protest is unfounded, the protest fee or part of it may be withheld. Protest fee: 300 000,- HUF

In the event of a technical protest requiring a disassembly, the stewards shall on the basis of a proposal from the technical steward may impose a deposit in addition to the protest fee. If the protest is unfounded, the costs of dismantling will also be charged to the protestor.

The competitor has the right of review and appeal against certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with the relevant Articles of the FIA International Sporting Code and the MNASZ General Sporting Rules and Regulations within the applicable time limits. Fee for appeal: 200 000,- HUF
