

Art. 3. 2026 FIA CENTRAL EUROPEAN ZONE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

3.1 Eligible Cars

- CEZ1 – Rally2 and R5 cars
- CEZ2 - 4WD cars (except Rally2 and R5 cars) + RGT cars + 2WD cars over 2000 cc
All cars with FIA homologations (including expired one) or ASN cars (with ASN rally technical passport)
- CEZ3 - 2WD cars
 - FIA homologated cars classes RC4, RC5 and RC6
 - FIA homologated cars expired one or ASN cars (with ASN rally technical passport) with following cylinder capacity:
 - petrol engine - corrected cylinder capacity up to 2000 cc
 - diesel engine - nominal cylinder capacity up to 2000 cc

3.2 Events counting towards the Championship

Venues and dates according the FIA CEZ Championship Calendar; (see www.cez-motorsport.com). Should the number of qualifying rallies organised finally be less than three, the Championship would be considered as not having taken place.

3.3 Organisation of the events

The events are to be organised according to the FIA International Sporting Code and its Appendices.

3.4 Classification

Points will be awarded, to the principal drivers correctly entered or designated as such, according to the scale: 25 - 18 - 15 - 12 - 10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1, in each of the groups mentioned in Art. 3.1.

The following drivers will be declared winners of the Central European Zone Rally Championship at the end of the year:

- The drivers (driver and co-driver) having scored the most points in CEZ1
- The drivers (driver and co-driver) having scored the most points in CEZ2
- The drivers (driver and co-driver) having scored the most points in CEZ3
