4.7 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted and in the case of the rally not taking place.

The Organisers will refund 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), are unable to start the rally.

5. INSURANCE COVER

Description of insurance cover:

Insurance cover guarantees the competitor's cover for civil liability towards third parties, according to the existing Regulations in Croatia, up to 135.000€ for personal damage and for damage to objects.

Each competitor must have an insurance policy for the vehicle he competes in, at competitor's request, the Organisers will take out an additional insurance valid for the period of the rally at competitor's expense.

The service and team vehicles, even those bearing plates issued by the Organisers, may never be considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owners.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

All advertising must be in accordance with Croatian laws. Advertising of tobacco products and alcoholic beverages is prohibited in Croatia.

Mandatory advertising of the organiser will be placed on the starting numbers and on the rally tables. The organiser's optional advertisements will be placed as shown in Appendix 4.

If the driver rejects the organiser's optional advertisement, he must pay a membership fee in the amount of 600,00€. Details about advertising during the rally will be published in the Bulletin.

The organiser reserves the exclusive right to any type of advertising in the rally office and alongside the rally shares. Any type of advertising must be approved by the organiser.

Starting numbers

Starting numbers provided by the organiser must be placed on the vehicle, in accordance with Appendix 4, for the entire duration of the rally. If it is determined that the competition number is missing at any time of the competition, it will be reported to the sports commission, which can impose a penalty in accordance with articles 12.3 and 12.4 of the FIA ISC.

Rally tables

Rally plates must be affixed to the vehicle as shown in Appendix 4 of this regulation for the entire duration of the rally. Under no circumstances may the front plate cover, even partially, the vehicle's registration plate. Such a violation will be reported to the sports commission, which can impose a penalty in accordance with articles 12.3 and 12.4 of the FIA ISC.

7. TYRES

7.1 Use of tires during the rally

There will be no specific use of tires during the rally.
The use of gravel tires of any profile is prohibited.

7.2 Track familiarization tires

Reconnaissance tires must comply with the specifications listed in article 35.2. 2024 FIA Sporting Regulations for Regional Rally Championships.

7.3 National laws or special requirements

There are no special laws and requirements for tires in Croatia. All laws are consistent with laws in other countries EU.

8. FUEL

All types of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.

8.1 Ordering procedure

There will be no ordering of fuel for this rally.

8.2 Closing date for ordering FIA fuel

There will be no ordering of fuel for this rally.

8.3 Procedure in Refuel Zone

There will be no fuel distribution at this rally.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Registration procedure

Each car must be identified with a reconnaissance car number supplied by the organiser. Rally cars used in the event may not be used for reconnaissance.

Materials for reconnaissance will be available:

- on Thursday, May 02nd 2024, from 8:00 till 19:00: At the Reception of the Hotel Terme Sveti Martin
- on Friday, May 03rd, 2024, in Rally HQ Hotel Terme Sveti Martin, from 08:00 till 14:00 hours

When registering for the reconnaissance, one of the crew members must be present and complete an information sheet giving details of the reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and place where the competitor is staying. The third-party insurance of reconnaissance cars must be presented during the reconnaissance registration. The reconnaissance ID number must be attached to the reconnaissance car on the top centre of the windscreen and on the rear left and right side and kept visible for the entire duration of the reconnaissance period.

In order the crew to perform at the Shakedown, they must register at the Administrative Checks and pay additional membership fee in the amount of **50,00€** (3 passes).

It is possible to take 2 more passes for an extra charge of **25,00€**. Performance at the Shakedown will be allowed for all crews who (with payment of the membership fee) have completed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering.

9.2 Specific and/or national restrictions – speed limit on the special stages

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organiser may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance and / or shakedown will be penalized up to start refusal applied by Stewards.

9.2.1 Any kind of practice on the rally route is forbidden.

9.2.2 Throughout the entire reconnaissance, the crews must strictly observe the traffic laws effective in the Republic of Croatia, which generally correspond to those in continental Europe. If not otherwise specified by traffic signs, the maximum permitted speed in populated areas is 50 km/h, outside populated areas 90 km/h, and on highways 130 km/h. Traffic camera detector systems are prohibited.

9.2.3 Each crew is allowed to pass each special stage **three** times during the reconnaissance.

9.2.4 The crews are required to present their reconnaissance cards to marshals at the start of each special stage.

9.2.5 In no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction to that of the rally in the special stages during reconnaissance.

9.2.6 Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the “3. MEĐIMURSKI RALLY”, who is found present on the route of any special stage of the rally before Thursday, May 02nd 2024, and/or outside the reconnaissance schedule, will be considered to be performing illegal reconnaissance.

9.2.7 The Organisers will control the route of special stages on a regular basis.

9.2.8 Any infringement of the reconnaissance regulations and particularly reconnaissance outside the given schedule will be considered a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty that may go as far as start refusal.

9.3 Installation of speed control checking devices

There will be no installation of speed control checking devices in reconnaissance cars, but there will be police along the special stages controlling the speed. Each breaking of the speed limit will be reported to Stewards.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 Documents to be presented:

- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences
- Driver's and co-driver's ID cards/passports
- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences
- Medical card
- ASN authorization, for all foreign competitors
- Fully filled application form
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car registration papers

10.2 Timetable

The administrative checks will take place according to the time and place specified in the program (PP article 3). Each crew will attend according to the schedule published in the Clerk of the Course communication.

11. SCRUTINEERING

11.1 Scrutineering location and timetable

The scrutineering will be held according to the time and place specified in the program (SR article 3). Cars can also be brought by team representatives.

Each crew will perform a technical check-in according to the schedule published in the Clerk of the Course communication.

11.2 Mud flaps

See ISC Appendix J, Article 252.7.7.

11.3 Windows

See ISC Appendix J, Article 253.11.

11.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

Driver's safety equipment is also described in Appendix 5 this Supplementary regulations.

11.5 Noise level

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J. There are no special restrictions on noise level in Croatia.

11.6 Special national requirements

Cars must be presented to the scrutineers with rally plates, competition numbers and optional advertising, if taken, affixed.

Any crew reporting late at administrative checks and scrutineering (according to the time indicated in the entry confirmation) will be penalized as follows:

- up to 30 min 50,00€
- 30 to 60 min 100,00€
- over 60 min 150,00€

11.7 Installation of Safety Tracking System

Safety Tracking Device will be provided during the collection of materials for reconnaissance/administrative checks and it has to be placed in the car before scrutineering. The deposit for the GPS devices will be driver and codriver license and will be return after return of the undamaged device. The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at scrutineering

12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 Ceremonial start procedure and order

The ceremonial start will take place on Saturday, May 04th at 14:00 hours, in front of the Hotel Terme Sveti Martin. All cars will start according to the Start list. Wearing racing overalls is mandatory.

12.2 Finish procedure

The competitive element of the rally will finish at the TC 11B.

12.3 Permitted early check-in

Crews are authorized to check-in early (before their target time) in the time controls at the end of the Section 1 (TC 2C), and when entering a Parc ferme (TC 11C) without incurring a penalty for early arrival.

12.4 Procedure at start of SS 3/6/9, 4/7/10 and 5/8/11

After the marshal at the start gives the crew the time card with the starting time for the road section entered, he will indicate the start lights with day time in hours, minutes and seconds. The lights will be red. 10 seconds before the start time digital clock will start to countdown rest seconds till start time. 5 seconds before the start time signal light will change from red to yellow. Start time will be signaled by changing yellow light to green which is tuned with start of start minute at clock. Green light continues to light until 20 seconds after full minute and on 21 second green light is changed to red. At start line will be photocells which are connected to measuring equipment with printer, tuned with above mentioned system and which register false start. **MANUAL START PROCEDURE** In case of manual start

procedure, after giving to the crew the time card, marshal at the start will countdown out loud : 30" - 15" - 10" and last 5 seconds one by one. After the last 5 seconds passes, the sign for the start will be given to the crew.

12.5 Starting System of Special Stages

Special stage – SS 1/2 Čakovec 1/2

After the marshal at the start gives the crew the timecard with the starting time for the road section entered, he will indicate the start lights. The lights will be red.

The driver has 30 seconds to get ready to start. The time to start is signaled by the light changing from red to green. The competing car must start within 5 seconds and the timekeeping will begin when the car crosses the photocell line after 0,5 meter. In case of the start light not functioning, the start will be given manually with flags.

Penalties: In the case that the crew drives less than estimated number of laps, it will be assigned with best time on the stage (in normal condition) + three (3) minutes.

12.6 Shakedown

In order the crew to perform at the Shakedown, they must register at the Administrative Checks and pay additional membership fee in the amount of **50,00€** (3 passes).

It is possible to take 2 more passes for an extra charge of **25,00€**. Performance at the Shakedown will be allowed for all crews who (with payment of the membership fee) have completed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering.

15. FINAL CHECKS/PROTESTS/APPEALS

15.1 Final checks - who is to attend from teams, plus location

Time and location: see programme (SR. Art. 3)

Any teams required to undergo final checks must immediately follow the instruction of the marshals in charge, even if this prevents them from proceeding to one or more time controls (TC). The complete original FIA homologation form and other necessary certifications must be available for final checks. For national cars the corresponding original ASN documents must be available.

15.2 Protest fees

The sum of the protest fee set by the ASN 60 €. Deposit for a protest which requires dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car is 650 €.

Request or complaint disassembly and reassembly of individual parts of the vehicle, the claimant must pay an additional deposit in the amount of 580.00€ if the complaint refers to one of the vehicle's parts (engine, transmission, steering, brakes, electrics, body, ...). If it is determined that the complaint is unfounded, the costs incurred by the operation and transportation of the vehicle shall be borne by the claimant. Otherwise, if the complaint is justified, the costs will be covered by the competitor against whom the complaint was filed. If the complaint is unfounded, and the labor costs for disassembling, reassembling and transporting the vehicle are greater than the deposit, the claimant bears the difference. Conversely, if the costs are less than the deposit, the difference is returned to the applicant. The Stewards can determine a higher deposit, if it deems it necessary.

15.3 Appeal fees

Sum for a national appeal fee (CCKF) is 700 €.



APPENDIX 2 - RECONNAISSANCE

During reconnaissance there shall be control marshals at the start and stop point of each special stage. Further checks may also be carried out during special stages.

Procedure for registration:

When registering for the reconnaissance, one of the crew members must be present and complete an information sheet giving details of the reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and place where the competitor is staying.

The third party insurance of reconnaissance cars must be presented during the reconnaissance registration.

The reconnaissance ID number must be attached to the reconnaissance car on the top centre of the windscreen and kept visible for the entire duration of the reconnaissance period.

APPENDIX 4 – COMPETITION NUMBERS

The organiser will provide each crew with the following, which must be affixed to their car in the positions stated prior to scrutineering:

1. COMPETITION NUMBERS

1.1 Two front door panels measuring 67 cm wide by 17 cm high including a 1 cm white surround.

Each of these panels shall comprise a 15 cm x 15 cm competition number box which shall always be at the front of the panel.

When the competition number is greater than 99, the box width may be increased. Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803), 14 cm high and with a stroke width of 2 cm, on a matt black background. The remainder of the door panel is reserved for the use of the organiser.

1.2 Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window.

1.3 No signage, other than the color scheme of the car, shall be placed within 10 cm of the panel.

1.4. One rear window panel which shall measure a maximum of 30 cm wide and 10 cm high, reserved for the use of the organiser. This panel shall be positioned at the top of the rear window, and positioned, left, or right, as indicated in the supplementary regulations. An adjacent area of 15 cm² shall contain the fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the rear at eye level.

1.5. Two numbers for each rear side window which shall be 20 cm high with a stroke width of at least 25 mm, colored fluorescent orange (PMS 804), and may be reflective. These numbers shall be placed at the top of the rear side windows in conjunction with the driver's name.

1.6. One plate fitting into a rectangle 43 cm wide by 21.5 cm high which shall include at least the competition number and name of the rally.

2. DRIVER'S AND CO-DRIVER'S NAMES

2.1. The first initial(s) and surname of both driver and co-driver, followed by the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their licenses, must appear on the rear side window on both sides of the car, adjacent to the competition number. The names must be:

- In white Helvetica

- In upper case for the initial(s) and first letter of each name with the remainder in lower case

- 6 cm high and with a stroke width of 1.0 cm.

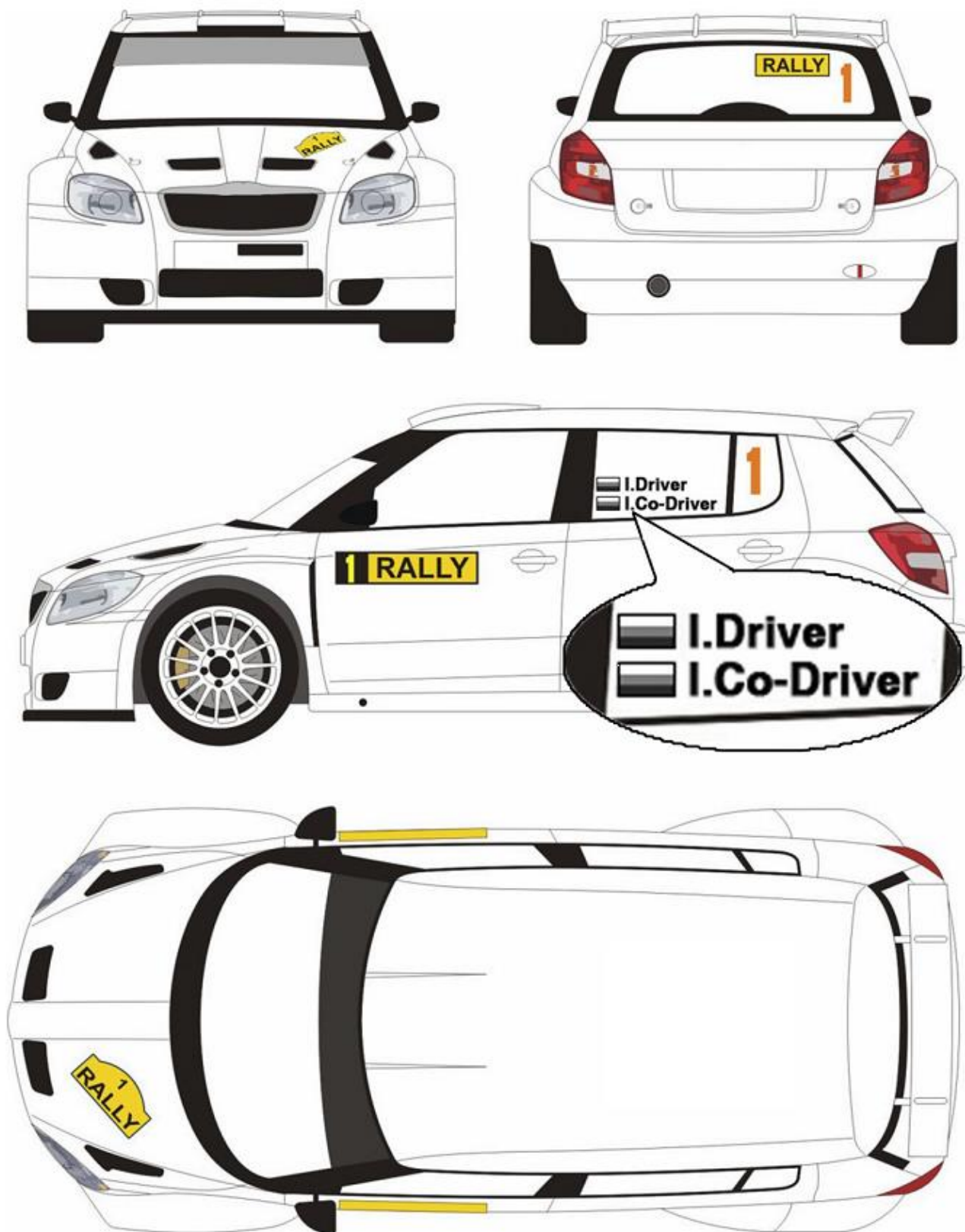
The driver's name shall be the upper name on both sides of the car.

In addition to Article 6.1, the names of the driver and co-driver, together with the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their license, must appear on the front wings of the car.

3. ORGANISERS OPTIONAL ADVERTISING

3.1. Organisers have the right to put 4 optional advertising stickers on every competitor vehicle, which are rectangular shape, wide 50 cm and 15 cm high, on the side of the vehicle, two on the front and two on the back fender.

APPENDIX 5 – COMPETITORS' SAFETY**1. Use of SOS/OK signs**

- Each competing car shall carry a red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 cm x 29.7 cm (A3).
- In case of an accident where urgent medical attention is required, when possible the red "SOS" sign should be immediately displayed to following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist.
- Any crew which has the red "SOS" displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered a major accident where both crew members are seen inside the car but are not displaying the red "SOS" sign, must immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. All following cars also have to stop. The second car at the scene shall proceed to inform the next radio point. Subsequent cars must leave a clear route for emergency vehicles.
- In case of an accident where immediate intervention is not required, the "OK" sign must be clearly shown by a crew member to the following vehicles and to any helicopter attempting to assist.
- If the crew leaves the vehicle, the "OK" sign must be displayed so that it is clearly visible to other crews.
- Any crew which is able but fails to comply with the above rules will be reported to the Clerk of the Course.
- Any crew retiring from a rally must report such retirement to the Organisers as soon as possible, save in case of force majeure. Any crew failing to comply will be subject to a penalty at Stewards' discretion.

2. Use of the red triangle

- Each competing car must carry a red triangle which, in the event of the car stopping in a special stage, must be placed in a conspicuous position by a member of the crew at least 50 metres before the car's position, in order to warn following drivers. Any crew failing to comply may be subject to a penalty at stewards' discretion.
- This triangle must be placed even if the stopped car is off the road.
