### Art.03 Official notice boards

All communications and decisions, as well as the results shall be posted on the official notice board, which is located as follows: in the race office, near the finish line and in parc ferme.  
Saturday and Sunday : 08, 09-05-.2020 parking place in front of the Drivers' association-Kocani.

## III General conditions

### Art.04 General provisions

04.1 The event shall be organized in conformity with the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code, FIA CEZ regulations and its appendixes, and the National Sporting Code and the provisions of these Supplementary Regulations.

04.2 By entering the competitions, the participants agree to abide by the above provisions and abandon all recourse to arbitrators or courts not provided for in the FIA International Sporting Code.

04.3 Any person or association organizing or taking part in an event and failing to comply with these provisions shall have their license withdraw.

04.4 The event counts towards the following Championships:

- FIA CEZ Hill Climb Trophy
- Macedonian Hill Climb Championships

#### **Art.05 Course**

The event will be run on the track "PONIKVA " which has the following characteristics:

Length	5910 m.
Minimum width	6 m.
Height above-start	820 m
Height above-finish	1540 m
Height difference	720 m

#### **Art.06 Eligible vehicles**

06.1 Each vehicle must have a national technical passport. All vehicles complying with the prescriptions of the FIA Appendix J for the following groups are eligible to take part:

**Division 1:** - Group N (incl. R1 cars) and Nat. H/N (passed homologation cars according the national regulations and safety equipment according actual FIA regulations; each of this cars must be accompanied by a confirmation of the home ASN that the car corresponds with the national regulations)

**Division 2:** - Group A (incl. R2 & R3 cars, WRC, Super1600), Group S20 (Super2000 rally & circuit combined, incl. R4 & R5 cars) and Nat. H/A (passed homologation cars according the national regulations and safety equipment according actual FIA regulations; each of this cars must be accompanied by a confirmation of the parent ASN that the car corresponds with the national regulations)

**Division 3:** - Group E1, Group GT

**Division 4:** - Group D/E2-SS (up to 3000 cc), E2-SH

**Division 5:** - Group CN, E2-SC (up to 3000 cc) For Groups E1, E2-SH, E2-SS & E2-SC the minimum weights acc. FIA App. J, Art. 277 have to be considered.

#### **Art.08 Drivers safety equipment**

08.1 The wearing of a safety belt and a crash helmet complying with the standards approved by The FIA is obligatory during the practice heats and the race, also at the way to the start.

08.2 Drivers are strictly obliged to wear fire-resistant overalls (including footwear, underwear, mask, gloves etc.) complying with the current FIA standard .

#### **Art.09 Eligible competitors and drivers**

09.1 Any person or legal entity holding a competitors license valid for the current year shall be Eligible. Also are obligated to have drivers license, valid medical confirmation and insurance policy.

09.2 Drivers for CEZ Championship defined in the CEZ regulations. Drivers for Macedonian Hill Climb Championship can drive with national or international drivers license for 2021. in compliance with the Rules of AFM and with the Rules of other participant.

09.3 Foreign competitors and drivers must be in possession of written authorization to take part in the event from the ASN, which issued them their license. If the drivers do not have his authorization, they may compete out of the concurrency of the international event, according to



the decision of the Stewards and on the proposal of the organizer (Recommendation-Promo drivers).

#### **Art.10 Entries**

10.1 Applications for entry shall be made on appropriate form in accordance to his supplementary Regulations, and should be sent to the following address:

10.2 Double starts (1 driver for 2 vehicles or 1 vehicle for 2 drivers) are not authorized.

#### **Art.11 Entry fees**

11.1 The entry fees shall be as follows:

With the organizers optional advertising  
- 50 EUR

Without the organizers optional advertising  
- 200 EUR

**Foreign license holders may pay on the verification**

The entry fees for Macedonian drivers are to be paid as follows:

In all cases, the entry fees include the competitors and drivers Civil Liability insurance Premium, as well as the necessary start numbers

11.2 The entry fees shall be refunded in full if the entry is not accepted or the event is cancelled.

#### **Art.12 Liabilities and Insurance**

12.1 Each participant shall take part on his own responsibility. The organizer shall refuse to accept any liability for personal injury or damage to property vis-a-vis competitors, drivers, assistants and third parties. Each competitor/driver shall be held solely responsible for his own insurance.

12.2 In accordance with legal regulations, the organizer has taken out an insurance policy or policies covering the following risks: third party Civil Liability for each case.

12.3 The Civil Liability insurance taken out by organizer shall apply for the entire duration of the event, not only during official practice and the heats of the race but also during trips from the parking area to the track and back.

12.4 Each driver/competitor by participating on the event, decline all the rights for compensation, concerning the accidents that may happen to competitor/driver or their mechanic during the practice or race, or during trips from parking area to the track and back. This concerns FIA, AFM, Automobile club "Perfomans", all officials and other competitors/drivers or their mechanics.

#### **Art.13 Reservations, official text**

13.1 The organizer reserves the right to add to his supplementary regulations or to issue additional conditions or instructions, which will form an integral part of them. He also reserves the right to cancel or stop the event in the case of insufficient participation, force majeure or unforeseeable events, without being under any obligation whatsoever to provide compensation.

13.2 Participants shall be informed of any amendments or additional conditions as soon as possible via dated and numbered information bulletins, which shall be posted on the official notice board.

13.3 Any cases not provided for in the supplementary regulations shall be decided by the Stewards of the meeting.

13.4 Only English version of these supplementary regulations shall be considered as the official authentic text.

## **IV Participants duties**

### **Art.14 Start numbers**

14.1 The organizer shall provide each participant with start numbers, which shall be clearly displayed on both sides of the vehicle throughout the entire duration of the event (on the front for formulas). Vehicles without correct start numbers will not be allowed to start the event.

14.2 The organizer shall be responsible for allocating the start numbers.

14.3 At the end of the event, before leaving the parc ferme on the paddock, the numbers of vehicles driving on public roads must be removed.

### **Art.15 Starting arrangements**

15.1 Drivers must place themselves at the disposal of the Clerk of the Course at least one hour before the start. The drivers shall accept the consequences should they be unaware of any conditions or modifications to the timetable which might be decided prior to the start.

15.2 The participants shall take their place in the starting file at least 10 minutes prior to their starting time. Any drivers who fails to report to the start at his scheduled starting time may be excluded from the event.

### **Art.16 Advertising**

16.1 Any advertising may be affixed to the vehicles, on condition that it complies with the FIA Regulations and is not offensive. No advertising may be affixed to the side windows.

16.2 The organizer has made provision for the following advertising:

Start number

Optional stickers, place reserved on front bonnet and on both sides of the car.

## **VI Running of the event**

### **Art.17 Start, finish, time keeping**

20.1 The start will take place with the vehicle stationary and the engine running. The Stewards of the meeting and the Clerk of the Course are free to modify the starting order according to the circumstances.

20.2 No vehicle may take the start outside its own group unless expressly authorized to do so by the Clerk of the Course with the permission of at least 2 members Stewards of the meeting.

20.3 Any vehicle which has triggered the timing apparatus shall be considered as having started, and shall not be granted a second start.

20.4 Any refusal in starting shall result in exclusion. Delay will be punished by financial punishment.

20.5 The finish shall be a flying finish. The training/heat ends when the vehicle crosses the finish line as soon as this is done, the vehicle must reduce speed drastically.

20.6 Timing shall be carried out using photoelectric cells accurate to at least 1/100 of a second.

20.7 Licensed timekeeping with appropriate electronic devices will carry out electronic processing of the results.

## **TYRE HEATING BEFORE ENTERING THE TIME MEASURING IS NOT ALLOWED IN PRE START ZONE.**

### **Art.18 External assistance**

- 23.1 Any external assistance shall result in exclusion.
- 23.2 Vehicles which have broken down along the route may only be towed away by order of the Clerk of the Course.
- 23.3 In the case of unexplained situations, the decision is on the Stewards of the meeting.

## **VII Parc ferme, final checks**

### **Art.19 Parc ferme**

- 24.1 At the end of the event parc ferme rules shall apply between the finish line and the entrance to the parc ferme.
- 24.2 At the end of the event, all classified vehicles shall remain in the parc ferme until indication to the contrary is given by the Clerk of the Course with the approval of the stewards. Parc ferme rules shall be lifted until the period of time allowed for the lodging of protests has expired.
- 24.3 The rules of parc ferme will start after finish line. Parc ferme is located in the specially organized place near the finish line, where the final checking shall take place.

### **Art.20 Additional checks**

- 25.1 Any vehicle may be subjected to final checking by the scrutineers, both while the event is taking place and especially after the finish.
- 25.2 At the request of the stewards, whether spontaneously or following a protest, a vehicle may be impounded after the finish and subjected to complete and detailed scrutineering entailing the dismantling of the vehicle
- 25.3 Special checks based on the Article 25 shall take place at the Service station Kocani.

### **Art.21 Protests**

- 27.1.1 The lodging of protests and the deadlines to be observed shall be in accordance with the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code.
- 27.1.2 Protest on the work of Scrutineering and administrative checking can be made 30 minutes after the end of work of the same commissions.
- 27.1.3 Protest on the results irregularities on the practice can be made 30 minutes after announcing the practice results.
- 27.1.4 Protests on the race running can be made 30 minutes after announcing the temporary race results.
- 27.2 The deadline for the lodging of protests against the results or the classification (Art.174 d of the ISC rule) shall be 30 minutes after the posting of the results on the official notice board.
- 27.3.1 The deposit for protests is set at 50 EUR and is to be paid in cash.
- 27.3.2 Mass protests and protests regarding time keeping or the decisions taken by the judges of fact are not accepted. The stewards in case of the availability of video or electronically evidence may overrule decisions taken by the judges of fact.
- Protest on the technical rightness of the vehicle can be made 30 minutes after the publishing of the temporary results.



If it is possible to check these irregularities by visual check fees is 50 EUR.  
If is necessary dismantling of the vehicle the resulting estimated costs shall be guaranteed by a deposit 500 EUR and additional bail check to be specified by the stewards in coordination with the Scrutineer. The deposit must be paid within the period specified by the stewards in order for this check to be carried out.

27.4 The right to protest can only be exercised by competitors who are duly entered in the Event, or by their representative (s) holding a written proxy (original document).

27.5 In the event of a protest necessitating the dismantling of the vehicle, the resulting estimated costs shall be guaranteed by a deposit to be specified by the stewards. The deposit must be paid within the period specified by the stewards in order for this check to be carried out.

## **Art.22 Appeals**

28.1 The lodging of an appeal and the related costs shall be in accordance with the provision of the FIA International Sporting Code.

28.2 The deposit for national appeals is set at 600 EUR to the Secretary of the event and is to be paid in cash. Then it is to be paid on the account of the AFM
